Husch Blackwell Attorneys Help Business Owners Navigate 'Guns in Trunks' Laws

Husch Blackwell attorneys have developed free online resources to help small business owners navigate changing gun laws and devise workplace violence policies.

During the last several years, more than 20 states have enacted "Parking Lot" or "Guns in Trunks" laws that allow employees to leave handguns in cars parked on employer property. Since federal law generally does not regulate firearms in the workplace, employers must become familiar with specific state laws, according to Husch Blackwell's Terry Potter, a partner in the firm's Technology, Manufacturing & Transportation group.

Potter and attorney Robert Rojas recently compiled and made publicly available their 50 State Survey of Workplace Firearms Laws report. The report describes individual state laws regarding firearms in employee parking lots and the requirements for posting notices that prohibit firearms on employer property.

"You have to look at each state to determine what your rights and responsibilities are as an employer," Potter said. "Employers should get acquainted with the laws in their state and consider putting a workplace violence policy in place."
