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# Husch Blackwell Assists Swift Current Energy in Sale of 1.5 GW Steel River Solar Project in Northeast Arkansas

Husch Blackwell’s renewable energy team assisted Swift Current Energy in the multi-year development and sale of the Steel River solar and storage project to Cypress Creek Renewables.

Husch Blackwell served as project development and local counsel to Swift Current in all aspects of project development, including real estate, permitting, environmental, tax, federal energy regulatory, and construction contracting.

The energy facility, located in Northeast Arkansas combines 750 MW of battery storage with 1.5 GW of solar generation in three equal phases and is expected to be placed in service in 2029, making it one of the largest solar and energy storage projects in the United States.
