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Husch Blackwell Represents GridLiance in Acquisition of TriCounty Electric Cooperative's Electric Transmission Assets

The closing also made effective a long-term co-development agreement between both parties. GridLiance will represent the interests of TCEC of Hooker, Oklahoma, and its members in planning and developing new transmission projects within the Southwest Power Pool, Inc.

"This is a tremendous step forward for GridLiance and its mission," said John Crossley, partner in Husch Blackwell's Energy & Natural Resources group. "We look forward to participating in the growth and development of this innovative company."
