Three Husch Blackwell Attorneys Named to Illinois Super Lawyers and Rising Stars 2013

Two Husch Blackwell Partners from the firm's Chicago office were named 2013 *Illinois Super Lawyers*, and one Partner was named a *Rising Star*. Edward D. Manzo has been named in the area of Intellectual Property Litigation and James P. White was named in Intellectual Property. Sherry L. Rollo was named a *Rising Star* in the area of Intellectual Property law.

Only up to 5 percent of attorneys per jurisdiction are named *Super Lawyers*. Selecting the attorneys involves an in-depth, measurable process. Peer nominations by seasoned attorneys followed by detailed evaluations are matched against third-party research. Each candidate is evaluated on 12 indicators of peer recognition and professional achievement. Selections are made on a state-by-state basis annually.

No more than two-and-a-half percent of attorneys in a state are named *Rising Stars*. The lawyers who make this list must be under 40 years old or have less than 10 years of legal experience. They go through the same selection process as *Super Lawyers*, excluding the peer evaluations.
