Husch Blackwell's Cory Collins Selected to *Springfield Business Journal's* 40 Under 40 Class of 2012

Springfield Business Journal named Husch Blackwell's Cory L. Collins to the 40 Under 40 Class of 2012. The award honors 40 area leaders under the age of 40 for their accomplishments as business and community leaders. Those selected were honored at an awards ceremony Thursday, May 17.

A Business Litigation Partner, Collins assists a wide variety of clients, from individuals to *Fortune* 500 companies. His litigation work includes construction, real estate development, employment, products liability, contracts, negligence and property claims matters.
