Husch Blackwell's Ike Skelton Receives Truman Good Neighbor Award

Skelton Recognized for His Public Service

On May 8, Husch Blackwell Partner Ike Skelton was presented with the Truman Good Neighbor Award. Each year on the anniversary of President Truman's birthday, the Harry S. Truman Good Neighbor Award Foundation honors an individual who has given exemplary service to their community and the nation.
