Survey Results: COVID-19-Related Return-to-Work Planning

Many clients have asked Husch Blackwell for ideas, counsel and advice regarding creating and implementing COVID-19-related Return-to-Work (RTW) plans. Drawing from the experience at our own firm—along with our early-stage work advising clients—it is clear that returning to our respective workplaces will be complex and potentially more difficult than instituting Work-From-Home protocols.

One challenge is that information is limited in how various enterprises are approaching RTW issues. That's not surprising; this is an unprecedented public health crisis, and no pre-existing playbook exists for the task ahead.
