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Husch Blackwell Relocates Jefferson City Office

Husch Blackwell announced the completion of construction on its new location in Jefferson City, Missouri. The firm will remain downtown as it moves from 235 E High St. to 630 Bolivar St., a three-story office building owned and operated by Farmer Companies.
