# Husch Blackwell Maintains Top 3 Ranking in Construction Executive's Seventh Annual Top 50 Construction Law Firms™ List

*Construction Executive* magazine has listed Husch Blackwell third in the seventh annual Top 50 Construction Law Firms™ rankings, which appear in the magazine's June 2025 issue.

For more than 20 years, *Construction Executive* has been the leading trade magazine covering the business of construction. In its June 2025 issue, CE published a comprehensive ranking of The Top 50 Construction Law Firms™ featuring breakouts and analysis accompanied by an article in which leading attorneys discuss their construction clients' most pressing business concerns.

To determine the ranking, CE asked hundreds of U.S. law firms with construction practices to complete a survey. Data collected included: 1) 2024 revenues from the firm's construction practice; 2) number of attorneys in

the firm's construction practice; 3) percentage of firm's total revenues derived from its construction practice; 4) number of states in which the firm is licensed to practice; 5) year in which the construction practice was established; and 6) the number of Architecture, Engineering and Construction clients served during fiscal year 2024. The ranking was determined by an algorithm that weighted these factors in descending order of importance.
