### OVERVIEW

His experience includes guiding institutions through fast-moving, high-sensitivity disputes where strategy must account for legal risk, governance realities, and reputational pressure.

Michael also represents businesses and organizations in complex commercial and statutory litigation, including disputes implicating the Federal Arbitration Act (FAA) and the False Claims Act (FCA), as well as consumer, contract, and trade-secret matters.
