OVERVIEW

Before law school, Timothy taught high school English, which built strong communication skills, discipline, and a focus on clarity. Teaching students from diverse backgrounds also strengthened his commitment to equity and careful listening.

He also completed a legislative policy externship with the Earl Carl Institute, researching proposed bills and analyzing the impact of policy decisions.
