Husch Blackwell Advises Benefuel Inc., Securing a Joint Venture Agreement with Flint Hills Resources Renewables LLC

In a breakthrough for the biodiesel industry, Husch Blackwell client Benefuel Inc., has completed agreements with Koch Industries subsidiary Flint Hills Resources Renewables LLC for the development of refineries that operate with Benefuel's unique process. The two companies have formed a joint venture – Duonix LLC – that is retrofitting an idled plant in Beatrice, Neb., for future production. Benefuel's patented ENSEL® technology generates high yields of biodiesel from low-cost feedstock, such as ethanol refining leftovers, waste vegetable oils, animal fats and unrefined oils. The Beatrice project – the first of many planned in the United States – is being funded partially by Japan's ITOCHU Corp., which is also expected to be a joint venture partner in Asia.

Husch Blackwell has aided Benefuel in numerous transactions over the past four years to bring about this partnership with Flint Hills, which Benefuel CEO Rob Tripp described as a “committed collaboration of two, world-class corporations.”
