## Husch Blackwell's Watson Receives Honorary Doctorate from William Jewell College

Husch Blackwell's Chairman Maurice Watson received an honorary Doctor of Laws degree from William Jewell College in Liberty, Missouri, during the school's commencement ceremonies May 13, 2017.

Watson, a member of the firm's Healthcare, Life Sciences and Education group, focuses his legal practice on representing educational institutions, including public and private schools and school systems, colleges and universities, and regional and national education associations. He also advises public, private and nonprofit boards.

Watson was appointed Chairman of Husch Blackwell in 2012.
