This allowed the team to defend the litigation aggressively, resulting in dismissals in all but one class action, which remains pending—although Seventh Circuit precedent recently established by Fathallah's team will soon end that case as well. The team's successes included obtaining dismissal of numerous nationwide class actions involving claims under unique coverage provisions for which no legal precedent existed prior to the pandemic.
