NON-MDL PRODUCT CASES HAVE EXPLODED OVER THE PAST DECADE, AND HUSCH BLACKWELL HAS EMERGED AS A GO-TO LAW FIRM TO DEFEND COMPANIES AGAINST THESE CLAIMS.

A new study into U.S. product liability litigation has found that Husch Blackwell is among the top three most active product liability defense law firms for the period ranging from 2018 to 2022.

The study, conducted by legal analytics firm Lex Machina, tracked federal court product liability litigation and determined that, except for a decrease in 2021, product cases have been on the rise for the past decade with a record 5,800 cases filed last year alone.

"Like everything we do, our growth is driven solely by our clients' needs. We continue to be asked to develop and deliver customized national coordinating counsel programs for clients across multiple industries. Using machine learning and technology-assisted attorney review, Lex Machina's Legal Analytics platform extracts data from PACER (Public Access to Court Electronic Records), which contains documents from federal district and appellate courts. According to Lex Machina, "[t]he raw data is then

cleaned, tagged, structured, and loaded into Lex Machina's proprietary platform."
